1) Overall Strategy

After the Government of Ontario's most recent announcement, we will continue to use and build on the protocols and procedures we established last season.

- ▶ As the pandemic situation evolves, we must all play our part and remain vigilant to ensure the safety of all.
- ▶ Our strategy remains to meet or exceed all standards as we aspire to provide you with a healthy environment and enjoyable experience as we move towards our 'Return to Racing' continuing our careful systematic approach.
- ▶ The following procedures are specifically tailored to Arrive-and-Drive Members and for Structured Training and Race Events.

2) Facility Limitations

- ▶ The facility is open to Arrive-and-Drive members only within a controlled - gate closed environment.
- ▶ No spectators or public walk-ins will be permitted. Limits to number of people on-site.
- ▶ Upon arrival, participants will register at the club house through a controlled process.
- ▶ Signing of the “Release of Liability Waiver” is mandatory prior to going on track.

2) Facility Limitations Continued...

- ▶ Our paddock area is very large. Parking will be controlled to ensure social distancing throughout our events. Your cooperation is needed.
- ▶ The paved area will be restricted as we look to spread-out. Designated parking spots will be on a first come first serve basis. Please stay within your space to maintain social distancing requirements when possible.
- ▶ As the paved paddock reaches our limit, cars will be directed to the grass hill. Please space out appropriately.

2) Facility Limitations Continued...

- ▶ Here is a link to the paddock map. Green spots are first come, first serve all others will be directed to grass areas.

- ▶ We will have staff dedicated to enforcing parking rules.
- ▶ Snack bar will be open using the take-out window only. The indoor portion of the snack bar will remain closed.
- ▶ Washroom and hand wash stations are restricted to one person at a time.

3) Physical Distancing Protocols

Goodwood Kartways has established guidelines and protocols to ensure proper physical distancing of all members, pre-registered visitors and employees. Expect the following:

- ▶ Defined parking spots as described above. Please stay within your parking spot when possible and throughout the event.
- ▶ On-site ‘Social Distancing Attendant’. Understanding how important it is to keep our distance, a Goodwood Kartways staff member will be dedicated to enforcing and reminding people to keep their space. Members must always stay 6ft apart.

3) Physical Distancing Protocols Continued...

- ▶ Each member may be accompanied by one parent and/or guardian figure only. No additional spectators are permitted at this time.
- ▶ Use of hand sanitation stations is required when entering club house.
- ▶ Anyone who ignores social distancing procedures will be asked to leave the premises for the remainder of the day.

4) Participant Eligibility

- ▶ As we 'Return to Racing', this package represents procedures for Arrive and Drive members only for training and racing activities.
- ▶ Only drivers who are members of the CRKC will be eligible to compete.
- ▶ Members can be accompanied by one parent and/or guardian.
- ▶ Members are required to leave with **EVERYTHING** you came with, waste included. Nothing can be shared and nothing can be left on site.

4) Participant Eligibility Continued...

- ▶ If you are at higher risk for severe illness, feeling unwell, travelled outside of Canada in the last 14 days or have been in contact with anyone who is sick in the last two weeks please stay home.
- ▶ Drivers and their guardians must come prepared with their own personal protective equipment (PPE). Face masks are mandatory when indoors and highly recommended while outside.
- ▶ Drivers are required to have full racing attire for any on-track session and are encouraged to own their own gear. Racing suits and helmets can be provided. A sanitation fee will be applied to those needing equipment. Equipment will not be shared during the event. Items will be restricted to single use daily.
 - ▶ Helmet fee: \$7.50. Racing Suit fee: \$7.50
